1. The Government of India (hereinafter called “Borrower”) has received financing from the World Bank towards the cost of Integrated Coastal Zone Management Project (ICZMP), and intends to apply part of the proceeds for consulting services.

2. The consulting services include the following:

Project Evaluation is to be carried out by the consultant appointed through this assignment. The consultant will provide services for a systematic and objective assessment of efficiency and quality of project implementation, efficacy of fulfillment of project objectives, and efficiency of the monitoring process and Annual Action Plans. Evaluation, through this assignment will provide information that is credible and useful, enabling the incorporation of lessons learnt in the decision making process by sharing knowledge gathered by evaluation through the process. Since evaluation is complementary to monitoring, it will provide feedback to the monitoring process and enable its revision.

The primary objectives of the “Monitoring and Evaluation of ICZM Project” are as follows.

Objectives

- i. To carry out a review of baseline conditions.
- ii. To review and refine the institutional benchmarks and knowledge benchmarks for project monitoring and evaluation.
- iii. To create an appropriate evaluation system including methodology and related processes for the entire ICZMP to enable evaluation of the project.
- iv. To evaluate the entire ICZM Project providing appropriate reports to satisfy the results framework of the project and complement the monitoring carried out. To continually provide investigative and diagnostic information through project evaluation that will enable changes to be brought in throughout the project. To finally consolidate and provide documentation of lessons learnt to the implementing agencies on the ICZM approach.

Duration:

The total duration of the assignment will be 12 (Twelve) months.

Society of Integrated Coastal Management (SICOM), Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change, now invites eligible consulting firms (“Consultants”) to indicate their interest in providing these Services. Interested consultants must provide information demonstrating that they have the required qualifications and relevant experience to perform the Services. The short listing criteria are experience of the organization in Monitoring & Evaluation projects including project management elements, experience of the organization in preparation of annual action plan and its implementation and financial capability.

The attention of interested Consultants is drawn to paragraph 1.9 of the World Bank’s Guidelines: Selection and Employment of Consultants under IBRD Loans and IDA Credits & Grants by World Bank Borrowers dated January 2011 (“Consultant Guidelines”), revised Jul 2014, setting forth the World Bank’s policy on conflict of interest.
5. Consultants may associate with other firms/ consultants to meet the necessary qualification criteria. The EOI submitted by consultants in association or consortium should clearly indicate the name of the lead firm [The “Association” or “Consortium” may take the form of a joint venture (with joint and several liability) or of a sub-consultancy] and nature of association or consortium.
